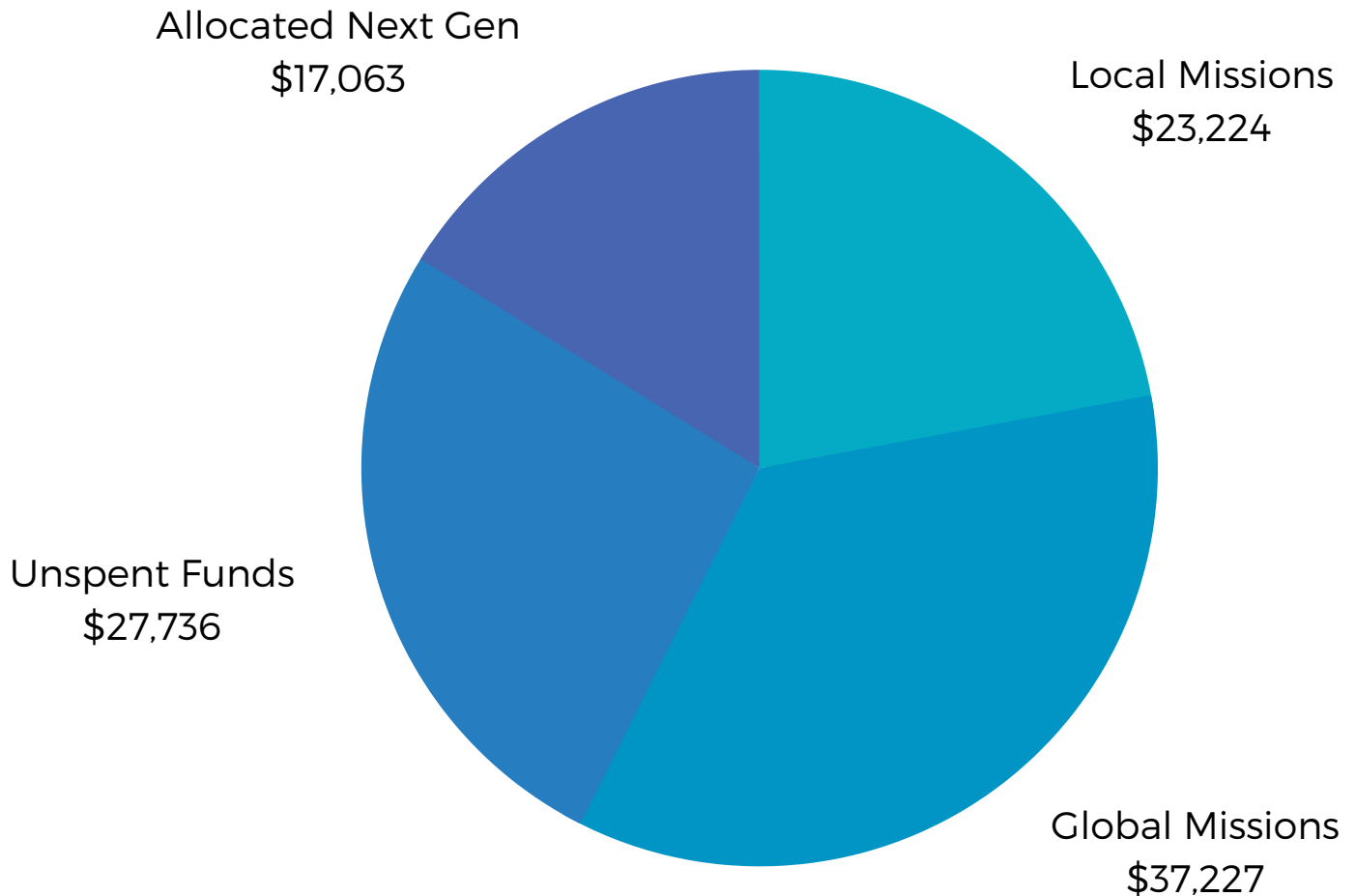

Turning Point Church facilitated **32 local outreaches** in 2022. Your Legacy dollars were able to help our frontline community ministries succeed in their mission of reaching people with the Gospel!

Leadership Development: focus on church planting through Discover Church Planting and Pacific Northwest Church Planting Network. Helping develop leaders through multiple pathways: Discover Ministry School, coaching, leadership pipeline and a residency program.

Expansion Projects: Capital and expansion projects for Turning Point Church campus, creating satellite campuses, or church planting facilities.



2023 VISION

This offering will bless the lives of people in five areas which we call our Five Legacy Lanes:

1. Local Missions. We love Spokane, and we believe God has given us our city as our first responsibility. Through our strategic ministry Community Partnerships: Life Services, HRC, Christ Kitchen, World Relief, SERVE Day, and SERVE outreaches we have more opportunities than ever before to impact the people of Spokane. Our team has vetted these opportunities to find the most critical needs and most effective places to make a difference. We're already doing a lot in our communities, but this offering will allow us to do even more. We are excited to announce a new ministry partner on December 4.

2. Global Missions. Our second area of focus is our world. We believe the local church is the hope of the world, and the best way to impact our world is by strengthening existing churches and helping plant new ones in other countries. This offering will not only build up life-giving churches that will change communities (like in Nogales, Mexico) it will also help build funds towards a church-planting project in Thailand in 2024. This offering reflects the heart of our God, who loves the whole world (John 3:16) and responds to the cry of Jesus to "go into all the world" (Matthew 28:19).

3. Next Gen. We love our young people! This includes children, youth students, and young adults. Our church has always been multi-generational, and it is our desire to be able to invest in the lives of our next Gen through scholarship opportunities for: mission trips, camps, leadership conferences, and more. Additionally, it is our vision to deliver current and up-to-date resources for Next Gen Dream Team leaders so they can continue to be successful in their roles.

4. Leadership Development. It is our desire to raise up and develop leaders, pastors, and missionaries who make an eternal difference for the Kingdom. We will also begin the development process of a ministry internship program. It is our goal in 2023 to launch something new...you will need to come to Legacy Sunday to find out more!

5. Expansion Projects. It is our desire to begin exploring options on how to best utilize the square footage of our beautiful facility. Looking at ways to help families in Spokane in hopes of growing their desire to Know God, and consider Turning Point Church a place that can help them on their spiritual journey. Additionally, we will design a space in our church building to help house Spokane County Sheriff Deputies. It is in this space they would be able to unwind, work on reports, receive snacks, and find a place of safety. We believe the Lord is calling us to steward every square inch of our facility towards Kingdom impact.
